NATIONAL WEBINAR ON INTERNATIONAL DAY OF INNOCENT CHILDREN VICTIMS OF AGGRESSION



College, Kannur) - speaker of the programme presented a talk on the topic "Ecological Restoration of Degraded Habitats: Role of Youth".




NATIONAL WEBINAR ON WORLD FOOD SAFETY DAY

TEACHER'S DAY



WORLD AUTISM AWARENESS DAY






poster competition organized by the Department of Pharmacology on April 2nd in association with the 'World autism awareness day programme' were announced.
