In order to improve the research aptitude of the college, all the faculty members and research students were encouraged to publish their papers in reputed journals.

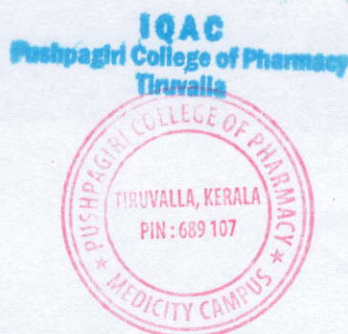
