Stake Holders Feed Back Report and actions Taken

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Pushpagiri college of Pharmacy has the mandate to design and collect feedback from its stakeholders to monitor and evaluate its quality on curriculum and curriculum-related issues. The feedback forms were collected from teachers, students and alumnis on several aspects of the curriculum and related issues in terms of quality, competence, skills and professionalism. The respective departments submitted the analysis and action taken report to IQAC, and then IQAC collated the report of feedback analysis. Although concerned instructors receive feedback from students during class hours, and teachers also provide feedback at department meetings, a methodical process for gathering feedback is being followed. After feedback was gathered, the data was statistically evaluated, and appropriate action was made based on pertinent viewpoints. According to stakeholder opinion, the relevant steps have been done and are summarised as

Students feedback report and actions taken:

Students' Feedback is an essential element of the learning process. The college collects the feedback on various aspects from the students using structured questionnaire. The feedback collected from the students has been analysed and action taken to strengthen the quality of teaching learning environment and to look for opportunities to improve overall performances including teacher in classroom engagement with students to bring excellence in teaching and learning. This questionnaire is intended to collect information relating to their satisfaction towards facilities and services provided for creating conducive atmosphere for teaching and learning. The information provided by the students was kept confidential and was used as important feedback for quality improvement of the various courses and programmes offered by Pushpagiri college of Pharmacy. In order to arrive at comprehensive results, statistical analysis and graphic representations has been undertaken. The responses are scored in a fivepoint scale for each item i.e., Strongly disagree, Disagree, neither agree nor disagree, Agree, Strongly Agree. Student indicates his / her level of agreement with the following statements by selecting appropriate option. Total consolidated responses received were 350 from both B.Pharm and M.Pharm, and Pharm.D students. The IQAC has analysed the responses of students' feedback form on curriculum design and report submitted to authorities, who in turn discuss at various fora, including meetings with the head of the departments

The majority of pupils gave satisfactory answers to questions about the curriculum and extracurricular activities offered by the school. The majority of students thought the admissions process and cost schedule were reasonable. According to the pupils, the professors were able to communicate well when they were instructing. The majority of students rated the performance as very excellent, and they expressed pleasure with the mentoring and teaching processes that are taking place at the institution. Although students responded favourably to the college's infrastructure and other amenities, the administration and head of the institution work tirelessly to improve the college. Recently, a freshly opened restaurant and refurbished library were made accessible.

Teachers feedback report and actions taken:

Instructions and updates from the director and principal which was subsequently analysed with departmental heads for taking necessary measures and actions as to comply with the issues raised by the different stockholders. The sample size of teachers' feedback was 35 teachers

from different departments collected with the help of form. The responses are scored over a five-point scale (Strongly agree, Agree, neutral, Disagree, strongly disagree) which reflected the viewpoints of faculty members from the different departments. IQAC taken the suggestions and discuss with authorities and accordingly authorities given the instructions to the departments for better quality improvement in the curriculum design and teaching learning process. Most of the faculties are grateful for the institution's happy and welcoming environment. To support college faculty members' research endeavours, the research lab's facilities were upgraded. In order to reduce the burden of the current faculty, new faculties were recruited. For reference, faculty members have a separate area in the recently remodelled library. Additional requests, such a wage increase, were granted



Actions taken: The library facilities were improved by increasing the number and variety of books. Ceratin new equipments purchased at college helps to conduct more research activities at college itself.


