
In the scientific session, Mr.Alok Kumar highlighted about growth of Indian pharmaceutical industry in global market. The students also cleared their doubts during the interactive session.



**REPORT ON INTERNATIONAL WEBINAR, 12<sup>th</sup> AUGUST 2023**


**Organized by:Scientific committee in association with IQAC**


