ORDER

1. The President, Kerala State Self Financing Pharmacy College Management Association [KSSPCMA], for short, the Association has submitted the common draft prospectus for the Thirty six (36) member colleges that come under the Association for approval of taking admissions towards Management and NRI quota of Pharmacy courses for the academic year 2025-26.

2. On Perusal of the draft prospectus submitted by the Association, it is found that the Pharmacy Colleges are under the Kerala State Self Financing Pharmacy College Management Association [KSSPCMA] and some of the member colleges are having minority status.
3. On scrutiny of the documents produced by the Association, it is seen that the member Pharmacy Colleges have not received orders of continuation affiliation from the Kerala University of Health Sciences and Pharmacy Council of India. Applications submitted by the Colleges for affiliation are pending before the concerned authority. The Colleges shall obtain necessary orders from the concerned authority as early as possible and, fact reported to the Committee without delay. In the meantime, the draft prospectus is provisionally approved. Subject to the condition that failure to obtain the requisite affiliation orders will render the provisionally approval or this prospectus invalid.
4. The Committee finds that certain modifications as enumerated hereunder are necessary as condition precedent to the approval of the draft prospectus submitted by the Association.
- (i) The List of Pharmacy Colleges and the distribution seats of B.Pharm, B.Pharm(Lateral Entry), Pharm.D, D.Pharm, M.Pharm Courses Management & NRI Seats, is shown hereunder:

- (ii) In the draft prospectus the clause “**Other Important Information /Points**”(caluse: b) shall be deleted and substituted by the clause shown hereunder:

“Candidates who express their intention not to pursue studies in the Pharmacy College before the last date fixed for closure of admissions will be eligible for refund of the 1st year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. They will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the College at the time of admission. In the case of students who leave the College midway, the right of the management for liquidated damages, if any, from such students will be determined by the competent “Civil Court”.

- (iii) Continuation affiliation orders from KUHS/PCI are awaited. Taking into account the likelihood of delay in completing the admission process, this prospectus is issued subject to the condition that appropriate modifications will be made on receipt of necessary orders from the institutions concerned, regarding affiliation. This clause shall be include in the Prospectus.

- (iv) In the place of the condition incorporated in the prospectus to the effect that “in the case of SC/ST candidates, they should remit their first year fees to the concerned colleges at the time of admission. The same will be refunded in case the Govt. pay the fees to the College”, the following shall be substituted:

“In the case of SC/ST candidates, their liability to pay fees shall be governed by the Orders issued from time to time issued by the Central and the State Governments and those of SC/ST Departments. No fees will be collected from SC/ST students or other eligible candidates except in accordance with the orders of the Central or the State Government.”

- (v) Collection of tuition fee, special fee etc. shall be as prescribed by the Fee Regulatory Committee (FRC). Pending issue of orders regulating the fee by the FRC, the College is allowed to charge the tuition fee and other fees applicable to similarly situated colleges. The college shall submit the fee proposal with relevant documents before the FRC without delay. Levy and receipt of fee on provisional basis is subject to modification depending on the fee regulated by the FRC. This fact shall be specifically stated in the prospectus.
- (vi) The Association has included in the prospectus the tentative schedule for admission. Tentative schedule provided in the prospectus is modified with the following changes in the dates:

5. The President of the Association is directed to obtain prior approval from the Committee at every stage of the admission procedure.
6. Applications shall be invited by the Association only through online. No other mode of inviting application shall be entertained.

The online application should contain the following particulars:-

- I.** Name of the Association with Address and Registration details should be included in the online application form.
- II.** The online application form should contain Auto generated Registration/ Application Number and auto generate date and time of submission of application.
- III.** The facility for uploading the photograph and signature of the candidate shall be provided.
- IV.** The category/quota shall be clearly specified in the online

application form.

- V.** The declaration of the candidate, as to the details provided in the application are true to the best of knowledge, should be included in the online application form.
- VI.** The facility for taking print out of the application shall be provided to the candidate by the Association.

The President of the Association shall ensure that the aforesaid particulars are included in the online application form.

- 7.** The Principal of the Pharmacy College shall ensure that the documents submitted by the aspirants for the N.R.I seats conform to the guidelines and directions contained in G.O [Ms] No. 243/2014/H&FWD DATED 06.08.2014 & G.O (Rt) No.375/2020/H&FWD dated 22.02.2020.
- 8.** The Association shall make the candidates aware of the amount of tuition fee, special fee, hostel fee and other fee details at the time of admission. This is necessary to avoid litigations and complaints.
- 9.** The President of the Association is directed to collect the tuition fee and special fee except the Admission fee, only through online payment/ Cheque/DD/RTGS/IMPS etc. If any amount is collected from the students, other than the fee fixed by the Committee, it would be considered as collection of capitation fee.
- 10.** The college is not entitled to retain the first year tuition and other fees, if the student discontinues the course before the last date of closing of admission stipulated by the competent authorities. Approval of the prospectus by the Committee is subject to the above condition.

- 11.** Certificates in respect of the community/minority quota category students shall be obtained from the revenue authorities as per the directions contained in the judgment of the Hon'ble High Court and the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
- 12.** The colleges have no right to retain the certificates of the students who may leave the college midway nor to refuse the request for issuance of T.C. The above documents shall be released to the applicant-student without any delay.
- 13.** Prospectus submitted by the Association, subject to the modifications, corrections etc. as directed to be made by this order, is provisionally approved for 2025-26.
- 14.** Provisional approval given as above is subject to the condition that the Association shall produce the affiliation order issued by the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) and Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) for 2025-26 confirming the conditional affiliation order without delay.
- 15.** If the Association fails to produce before this Committee any of the above mentioned documents, the provisional approval given by the Committee as per this Order will stand cancelled ab initio and in the event of such cancellation all steps taken by the College including the admission of candidates to the Pharmacy Courses for 2025-26 will stand cancelled holding the College responsible and liable for the consequences ensuing there from. The Association shall make the candidates aware of the aforesaid conditions before giving admission to the Course.

16. The President of the Association is directed to submit the modified prospectus before the Committee after making the aforementioned corrections and incorporating the modifications, at the earliest. The modified prospectus alone shall be uploaded in the College website.
