ORDER

Government are pleased to approve the seat matrix for admission to the Master of Dental Surgery course(MDS) in Self Financing Dental Colleges for the academic session 2020-21 as appended to this order.

2. The methods and principles adopted for arriving at the above seat matrix are explained below:

In Self Financing Dental Educational Institutions, leaving aside the seats under NRI and Minority Community quotas, the remaining seats are distributed between the General (unreserved), SC, ST and SEBC categories. Reservation for SC (8%), ST (2%), SEBC candidates (9%) with internal further distribution Ezhava 3%, Muslim 2%, BH 1%, LC 1%, B Xian 1%, Kudumbi 1%, is incorporated in the roster.

(a) Roster Preparation

- (i) Roster for the current year is prepared as an extension of the last year's roster.
- (ii) Assignment of reservation categories to roster points is driven by computing the gap between the total share of seats due to the categories and the seats actually allocated up to that point in the extended roster.
- (iii) Mapping of categories to roster points makes use of a category hierarchy, with blocks of reserved and unreserved seats at the top level, and the block of reserved seats further divided in to the SC-ST and the SEBC blocks at the next level. The SC-ST and SEBC blocks in turn are divided in to the respective constituent categories at the bottom level.

(b) Assignment of seats to roster points for forming the seat matrix

- (i) Seat Matrix for the current year is prepared as an extension of the last year's seat matrix.
- (ii) After reservation categories are assigned to roster points, the next step is to map roster points to seats. The procedure for mapping roster points to seats in participating institutions relies on a well defined hierarchical grouping of the seats available at the time of seat matrix preparation. At the highest level, there is a distinction between subjects and the next level is defined institution-wise.
- (iii) The roster points with categories assigned to them are processed one after the other. When a roster point is considered for mapping to a seat, the unassigned seats are examined along the seat hierarchy defined above. At each level of the hierarchy, choice of seat is made based on a computation of the gap between the due seats and the seats accrued up to that stage in the extended seat matrix in respect of the concerned category, separately for the constituent groups at that level. The group in which the category is having higher deficit will be pursued. This logic is applied through the levels until the bottom most level is reached and the roster point will get assigned to a seat in a particular speciality and institution combination.
- (iv) In case additional seat(s) is / are contributed by any institution after finalization of seat matrix due to creation of additional seat or starting of new course after freezing of seat distribution (seat matrix), before start of next round (second / third) of counselling the same will be added to the roster and the seat matrix by applying the above defined procedures for extension of roster and seat matrix.
- (v) In case an institution withdraws any seat after finalization of seat matrix as mentioned above, on account of de-recognition of seat or due to furnishing of wrong information earlier, the same would be deleted from the list without changing/disturbing remaining seat matrix. However, as the deleted seats will not be part of the accrued seats when the next extension (due to availability of additional seats or the next year's seat matrix preparation) of the roster and seat matrix takes place, the lost assignments of seats to roster points will be automatically compensated when such extensions happen.

a. Methods followed

- i) For identification of Open (Unreserved), SC, ST, SEBC (BH, BX, EZ, KU, LC, MU) as done in the same way as is done for the admission in Post Graduate Dental Degree courses in the Government Dental Colleges.
- ii) In Government Dental Colleges besides reservation for SC (8%) and ST (2%) there is reservation for SEBC candidates (9%) with internal further distribution Ezhava 3%, Muslim 2%, BH 1%, LC 1%, B xian 1%, Kudumbi 1%. These norms will be followed for allotment to all PG Dental seats (except NRI) in Non Minority Medical Institutions and in such number of seats which are set apart in Minority Educational Institutions for filling up as per the State Reservation Policy.

b. The principles followed

i) All Self Financing Dental colleges will be arranged in alphabetic order. Within each institution, the post graduate degree Subjects will be arranged in alphabetic order clinical first and later non clinical.

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ii) After completion of all PG Degree seats of one Self Financing Dental college, the PG Degree seats of the next Dental college will be arranged on same roster. For identifying the seats for reservations category the block of SC and ST shall be created. The community rotation within the block is on the five point internal roaster as follows

SC-SC-ST-SC-SC to ensure the internal rotation of 8% for Scheduled Caste and 2% for Scheduled Tribe and and will be repeated in sequence.

iii) For identifying seats for reservation for SEBC the block of SEBC shall be created. Internal roaster for SEBC shall be on the nine point internal roaster as follows

EZ-MU-BH-BX- EZ-KU-LC-MU-EZ and will be repeated in sequence.

In next year the roster will start from the next roster point.

- iv) In case additional seat(s) is / are contributed by any institution after finalization of seat matrix due to creation of additional seat or starting of new course after freezing of seat distribution (seat matrix), before start of next round (second / third) of counseling the same will be added from next available roster point as and when received in order of date and time of receipt to avoid any human bias.
- v) In case the institution withdraw any seat after finalization of seat matrix as mentioned above, on account of de-recognition of seat or due to furnishing of wrong information earlier, the same would be deleted from the list without changing/ disturbing remaining seat matrix.
- vi) The allocation of seat in the year shall be followed up next year in the sequence of subjects arranged alphabetically in the roster.

3. The allotment in Community/NRI quota seats shall be as per the inter se merit. Seat distribution is given in **Annexure III**

4. Fee structure

The Hon'ble High court in its judgement dated 28.02.2019 in WP(c) No.31473/2017 cancelled the fee fixed by the Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee (AFRC) for the previous years and directed to fix the fee afresh, till then fee already fixed by the Committee will be provisional. There is also a court direction to reconsider the constitution of 10 member AFRC. The draft ordinance approved by the Council of Ministers to amend the Act No.15 of 2017 having provision to bifurcate the existing jumbo committee to two smaller committee is under consideration of Election Commission for Model Code of Conduct clearance. In such a situation, fee for the current years PG admission in Self Financing Dental Colleges could not be fixed so far.

It is incumbent upon the Government to ensure that the admission process is completed as per the time schedule fixed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court. In order to ensure benefit to the students to get admission in Post Graduate Degree courses in Self Financing Dental Colleges and in such a compelling situation, it has been decided to retain the Last years fee for the ensuing academic year also till the new Committee is constituted and fee fixed.

Candidates shall execute an undertaking to the respective Institutions on a bond paper of **Rs 200/-** in **Annexure IV** format stating that the difference in fee, if any, as per the decision of the Committee to be constituted under the Ordinance shall be paid by them within one month.

The senior residents on bonded obligation in Self Financing Dental Colleges shall be relieved of in the event of getting appointment under DHS/DME/Insurance Medical Service subject to the outcome of the pending litigation in this regard in case WP(c) No.25957/2018 before the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala.

- **5.** For admission to PG Degree courses in Self Financing Dental Educational Institutions having minority status, instructions as ordered in the Government Order read above shall be followed.
- **6.** Community certificate issued by the Revenue Authority shall be produced for claiming reservation of seats under minority quota.

6.1.6(i): Reserved Seats under Service Quota when so made, shall carry over as follows:

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- a) Seats reserved for MESQ Shall revert to HSQ and if there are no candidates in HSQ, it shall revert to IMSQ.
- b) Seats reserved for HSQ Shall revert to MESQ and if there are no candidates in MESQ, it shall revert to IMSQ.
- C) Seats reserved for IMSQ Shall revert to MESQ and if there are no candidates in MESQ, it shall revert to HSQ.

6.1.6(ii): Summary: The split up of the reservations will thus be as follows: Total No of MDS Seats in Govt. Dental Colleges: 50% will be All India Quota. 50% will be State Quota.

From the State Quota seats, leaving the 3% seats set apart for persons with disabilities, 50% seats are distributed as General merit and the remaining 50% is distributed as follows

9%: - SEBC.

10%: - 8%SC/2% ST

6.1.6.(iii): Prerequisites: All candidates including those claiming reservation seats shall have to duly qualify in the NEET MDS 2018 with the minimum prescribed marks for the particular reservation category to be eligible for admission to any MDS courses in 2018 as per Clause .4 (d) (2).

7. Determination Criteria for Claims for Reservation:

7.1. SEBC:

- **7.1.1:** Reservation to the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes will be in accordance with the provisions contained in G.O. (P)208/66/Edn. dated 02.05.1966, G.O.(MS) No.95/08/SCSTDD dated 06.10.2008,G.O.(Rt) No.3742/2009/H&FWD dated 24.12.2009 and GO (P) No.1/2015/BCDD dated 01/01/2015, and as amended from time to time.
- 7.1.2: Candidates belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Classes as per G.O.(P) No.208/66/Edn. Dated 2.5.1966 and GO (P) No.1/2015/BCDD dated 01/01/2015 Should produce a certificate to the extent that the candidates belongs to the community which is designated as a Socially and Educationally Backward Class and does not belong to the category of Creamy layer, in the proforma given as Annexure XII of the prospectus. Only the claims of the candidates of those communities that are included in the SEBC list as Annexure III will be considered. Claims by candidates belonging to other communities, which are not included in the list, will be rejected even if certificates from the concerned Revenue Officers have been obtained and furnished along with the application form.
- 7.1.3: Candidates claiming reservation under SEBC Quota should invariably produce Non-Creamy layer Certificate from the Village

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candidates are requested to visit the website for the same. The course wise and college wise distribution of the available seats in Self Financing Dental Colleges for different specialties will be furnished later before the CAP.

Note: Allotment of seats from the rank list for all MDS courses in Self Financing Dental colleges will be made in accordance with the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India / Hon'ble High Court of Kerala or the orders of the Government of Kerala / Government of India as per the law in existence at the time of the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) and subject to the Self Financing Dental Colleges entering into consensual agreement (if any) with Government.

6. Allotment of Seats under State General Merit Quota and other Reservation Quotas.

- **6.1: Reservation for All India Quota for MDS Courses**: These are the 50% seats set apart in MDS courses in Government Dental colleges in the State for candidates allotted by Government of India-DGHS, through the NEET-2020. These are not included in this prospectus.
- **6.2: Reservation for Persons with Disabilities:** Person with disabilities category (PD) candidates are given 5% reservation, which is distributed among all the categories
- **6.3:** State General Merit quota :- 50% of the seats under State Quota will be allotted under General Merit .

6.4: Reservation for Socially and Educationally Backward classes (SEBC):-

Leaving the seats set apart for Persons with disabilities – (5%), 9 % of the remaining seats under State quota shall be reserved for candidates belonging to socially and Educationally Backward Classes. The percentage break up of seats as per the SEBC reservation is shown below.

- **6.5:** The seats if any Unavailed by the Reservation candidates will be transferred to State Merit quota.
- **6.6:** Reservation for Scheduled Castes / Scheduled Tribes (SC/ST):- 10% of the seats under State Quota will be given to Scheduled Caste (8%) and Scheduled Tribe (2%) candidates.
- **6.7: Un-availed seats of Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe:** The seats un-availed of, by the SC candidates will go to the ST candidates and

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vice versa. The seats Un-availed by both the SC and ST candidates will go to OEC Categories. (G.O.(MS)No.14/2017/SCSTDD,Dated.02.02.2017).OEC candidates should upload Non-Creamy layer Certificate should be "state education purpose" obtained from the competent authority of Revenue Department concerned for the claim of un-availed seats of SC and ST candidates. The seats that still remain un availed of, if any will go to the General Merit Quota.

- 6.8 : Admission of Government Service candidates:- No seats are reserved for service category. However weightage in the marks may be given to candidates in the Government service as an incentive upto 10 % of the marks obtained for each year of service in remote and / or difficult or rural areas upto the maximum of 30% of the marks obtained in NEET. The remote, difficult and rural areas shall be defined by State Government/competent authority from time to time.(Published in the Gazette of India, Part III, Section 4)(DCI Notification No. 87/2017,
- 6.9: Prerequisites: All candidates including those claiming reservation seats shall have to duly qualify in the NEET MDS 2020 with the minimum prescribed marks for the particular reservation category to be eligible for admission to any MDS courses in 2020 as per Clause .4

7: METHOD FOLLOWED FOR ARRIVING AT THE SEAT

- 7.1: For identification of Open (Unreserved), SC, ST, SEBC (BH, BX, EZ, KU, LC, MU) and Person with disability seats in Open (Unreserved), SC and ST, SEBC Categories in respect of Government Dental Colleges:
- 7.2: In Government Dental Colleges/ Institutions besides reservation for SC (8%) and ST (2%) there is reservation for SEBC candidates (9%) with internal further distribution Ezhava 3%, Muslim 2%, BH 1%, LC 1%, BX 1%,
- 7.3: Person with disabilities category (PD) candidates are given 5% reservation, which is distributed among all the categories.
- 7.4: The principles to be followed:-
 - (a) Roster Preparation
 - (i) Roster for the current year is prepared as an extension of the last year's roster.

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
